I would ask for the adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator DeCamp, on the bill as amended.

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, I move it be advanced. He has explained everything.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Any further discussion on LB 885 as amended? If not, all those in favor of advancing LB 885 as amended vote yes, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill as amended is advanced. The Chair is going to announce that we are going to take a couple more bills and then there is a motion on the desk that we will take up. We are not going to spend any time on it and then we are going to adjourn. I hope that will meet with the approval of the Speaker since he is not here, but I begin to sense some restlessness in the body and I think that tells us something. So let's try a couple more bills and then call it quits for today. Mr. Clerk, the next bill, LB 1143.

CLERK: 1143 was introduced by the Revenue Committee. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 22. It was referred to the Revenue Committee for public hearing, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.
