SENATOR HEFNER: Senator Higgins, I believe I said that this money would not come out of the General Fund. It would come out of the Highway Trust Fund.

SENATOR HIGGINS: It would come out of the Highway Trust Fund.

SENATOR HEFNER: Yes.

SENATOR HIGGINS: And how much money would it amount to?

SENATOR HEFNER: That depends upon how many samples we have to take. It's estimated about from 60 to 65 thousand dollars a year.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you.

SENATOR HEFNER: But we're hopeful that we probably generate a lot more than that because we feel that there are a few dealers that are not adding the full 10 percent to the gasoline.

SENATOR HIGGINS: But if you generated more, would that go into the Highway Trust Fund?

SENATOR HEFNER: That would go into the Highway Trust Fund, yes.

SENATOR HIGGINS: But at this point in time, you're saying it would take 60,000 out of the Highway Trust Fund, but you don't have any definite figures on how much would go back in.

SENATOR HEFNER: No, we don't.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Okay, the motion is to advance LB 1143 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Have you all voted that care to? Senator Hefner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, how many are excused?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Ten are excused, Senator Hefner.
