SENATOR HEFNER: That leaves us with 39. I would ask for a call of the house.

SENATOR CARSTEN: A call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of going under call vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All those senators that are within hearing of my voice, please return to the Chamber. We are under call. We would ask that unauthorized people leave the floor, please. Record, Mr. Clerk. We can't...Senator Hefner, do you want to authorize some call ins?

SENATOR HEFNER: I'll take some call ins.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Call ins will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Smith changing from no to yes. Senator Nelson changing from no to yes. Senator Scofield voting yes. Senator Harris voting yes. Senator Hartnett voting yes.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill as amended is advanced. The Chair would like to make this announcement and together with an apology. I did not read the agenda very carefully and when I made my statement about the troops being restless, still holds, but the agenda does say two o'clock. If the body would continue for a little while longer, I will back off of my earlier statement and stand corrected and we will proceed. If there are objections, I wish you would voice them, but we will try to stay with as close to that agenda as we can. Next bill is LB 1203. Mr. Clerk.
