SENATOR HOAGLAND: For the reasons earlier stated, colleagues, I'd ask the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The motion is to advance the bill as...Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: (Response inaudible.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: The motion is to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill as amended is advanced. Senator Landis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR LANDIS: I rise to move that we adjourn until Tuesday morning at nine o'clock.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Landis, if I may request you to withhold that motion, we do have another motion that I want to bring up and we're running close to time, I realize that.

SENATOR LANDIS: Motion to adjourn is a priority motion.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I understand. Okay? The motion is to adjourn until Tuesday morning at ten o'clock. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no, and I'm not going to ask for a voice vote, I want a machine vote. Ten seconds more for registering your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 6 ayes, 19 nays to adjourn, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: We are not adjourned. Now you have a motion on the desk, Mr. Clerk? Would you read the motion, please.

CLERK: Yes, sir. Senator DeCamp would move to suspend the rules and allow a vote on LB 968.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator DeCamp.
