SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Higgins, please.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. President. As you know I am not in favor of these basketball resolutions and I haven't been for five years but it is such a rare thing for us to ever be able to get up and compliment women for their achievements that I agreed to co-sponsor this resolution. And I am extremely proud of Maurtice Ivy from Omaha and for her accomplishments, and for that reason, this is the first time in the five years that I have been a Senator that I have ever signed on a basketball resolution or a resolution recognizing someone for their athletic abilities. CLERK: (Read LB 839 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 839 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
