SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Roll call, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right we'll turn over on the back page to number nine, if you would please. We'll go to LB 289.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 289 was a bill that was introduced by Senator Hannibal. (Title read.) The bill was read on January 17 of last year, Mr. President. At that time it was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill did have a public hearing. On March 29 of last year Senator Hannibal moved to raise the bill from committee. That motion prevailed. Mr. President, I do have amendments pending.
