It was not a substantive change in it. I'd move its adoption.

SENATOR HABERMAN: This doesn't eliminate the registration requirement, it just changes it that they register them after they've been issued. Is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: That's correct.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on LB 425 and an amendment thereto? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Warner to 425. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion before the house is an amendment to LB 425 offered by Senator Warner. Please record your vote. May we have the attention of the membership, please, to the matter before us, an amendment offered by Senator Warner to LB 425. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Warner's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
