

Senator Conway, could we please have your attention. Silence in the Chambers. Reverse order. Roll call vote. Advancement of the bill.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken in reverse order. (See pages 1347-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill advances. Do you have anything else to put into the record, Mr. Clerk? Ladies and gentlemen, we have some bills to introduce, some appropriation bills to introduce, so we must have 30 votes to introduce these at this time, so please stick around for a little bit here.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion Senator Warner has to offer is move for the introduction of Request 1920.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would move its adoption. It was 1920?

CLERK: Request 1920, yes, sir.

SENATOR WARNER: This is the bill that deals with salaries for state employees for '86-87. I move the rule be suspended and allow its introduction.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is to introduce the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. This is for the introduction of the bill. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to introduce that request, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Warner would move for introduction of Request 1905.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this is an appropriations bill for operations and aid programs. I move that the rule be suspended for its introduction.
