

the committee amendments on page 2, line 6, strike the date "July 1, 1987" and insert "October 1, 1987".

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Rogers, please.

SENATOR ROGERS: Mr. Speaker and body, the reason that we delayed this implementation date, I'd had a few problems with the Ag Department on them wanting to hire a person before the implementation date which would have been in the fiscal year '86-87 to train this person which would have required an A bill for '86-87. So we delayed the implementation date giving them a chance then after 1987 to train this person. So it simply delayed it for three months so that they would have that opportunity to train this one person in '87-88 after the bill is implemented.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Any further discussion on the amendment to the committee amendments? If not, all those in favor of Senator Rogers' amendment will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Rogers' amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The amendment to the committee amendment has been adopted. Senator Rogers, do you have anything more on the committee amendments as amended?

SENATOR ROGERS: No.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Johnson, do you have anything more?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: I would just move for the adoption of the amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the committee amendments as amended be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Rogers, now back on the bill as amended, please.
