SENATOR BEYER: That goes to the Department of Roads.

SENATOR HALL: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR HALL: All right, thank you.

SENATOR CARSTEN: All those in favor of the Beyer amendment to LB 783 will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Beyer's amendment.
