SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Abboud, please.

SENATOR ABOUD: Mr. President, colleagues, would Senator Beyer yield to a question?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Beyer, will you respond?

SENATOR BEYER: Yes.

SENATOR ABOUD: Senator Beyer, I hate to be a stickler for details, but what exactly does the amendment do?

SENATOR BEYER: Basically it gives the carrier enforcement the authority under 301, spells it out in these particular sections and it just adds in the language, in LB 783, it adds, includes Sections 1 to 6 of LB 301, the Eighty-ninth Legislature, Second Session.

SENATOR ABOUD: What does that do?

SENATOR BEYER: Basically, it says here that it is in...purpose of enforcing the law as relating to the trip permits and the size, weight, load and registration of motor vehicles and everything, and they left that particular part out of 301.

SENATOR ABOUD: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CARSTEN: No other questions? The question is then, shall the second Beyer amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Beyer's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The second Beyer amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Beyer, back on the bill as amended.
