SENATOR DECAMP: Mr. President, Senator Johnson asked me a question a while ago, kind of caught me off guard, had to do with whether I supported the bill or how I could in good conscience support the bill if it would generate a tax increase. Okay, my answer, now that I have regrouped, Senator Rex Haberman of Imperial has made an absolute promise to me that he knows that the bill can't pass unless he comes up with the money for it, \$4 million, or thereabouts, whatever. So that is my explanation.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Schmit, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I call the question.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question has been called for. Do I see five hands? I see two, three, four, I do see five hands. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Senator Haberman, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of going under call will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.
