CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to return the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries and the bill is returned. It is now on Select File. Do you wish to propose the amendment, Senator Schmit? Do you wish to propose the amendment now? The bill is on Select File.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the amendment. Any further explanation? Any comment on the motion to adopt the amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment offered by Senator Schmit to LB 491. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are on Select File. Twenty-five votes are required. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, the amendment is adopted. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move that the bill be readvanced.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance the bill from Select File to final Enrollment and Review. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried, the bill is readvanced.
