LB 781, 819, 831, 864

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 781 is declared passed. Next is LB 819. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would just ask unanimous consent to pass this bill over. This bill is resulting in some ongoing exchanges between the City of Omaha lawyers and lawyers for the Land Reutilization Authority in Omaha. They specifically asked me if I would hold this bill until they have completed their nego...their conversations about what changes should be made in the current application of the Land Reutilization Authority Act, and I said I would be more than happy to ask my colleagues to do that. So I would like unanimous consent to pass the bill over.

PRESIDENT: Is there objection to Senator Johnson's request? If not, so ordered. The bill is passed over. LB 831.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 831 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all recorded your vote on the final passage of 831? Please record your vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1409 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next is LB 864.

CLERK: (Read LB 864 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 864 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on 864. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.
