PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next is LB 869 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 871 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 871 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the final passage of 871. Have you all voted? Please record your vote on 871. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1411 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting, Mr. President.
