SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Nelson, please.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. President, members of the body, could I ask Senator Vickers a question, please?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers, would you respond, please.

SENATOR NELSON: I know it probably doesn't have anything to do with the bill, and if it did, we probably couldn't do anything about it anyhow because of the 5.6 million. Is this the same program that lunches and so on are paid for through day care centers or home baby-sitting services and so on? I wonder what, you know, it's a lot easier if it's handled I guess through the USDA and so on to pass out the cheese, but now what will happen to this or is this the same program? Do you know that?

SENATOR VICKERS: As I understand it, it's a different program, but it is basically the same type of thing, only it applies to a little different service than what you're referring to.

SENATOR NELSON: Probably won't...well, I guess we'd be guessing whether it would affect that or not. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers, would you like to close?

SENATOR VICKERS: No.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, the question is the adoption of the Vickers amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the Vickers amendments. Please vote if you care to. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
