Claims Board and referred to this Legislature. I move for the adoption of Request 1910.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All those in favor of introducing Request 1910 vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you care to. It takes 30 votes. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the introduction of Request 1910.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is introduced. Do you have anything to put in at this time, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, new bills. (Read LB 1255, LB 1256, and LB 1257 for the first time by title. See pages 1431-32 of the Legislative Journal.) Those three will be referred to the Reference Committee, Mr. President.

Senator Chambers has amendments to LB 1048; and Senator Chronister has amendments to LB 190 to be printed, Mr. President. (See pages 1432-36 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Then we will move on to LB 131.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 131 is on Select File. I do have E & R amendments on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall, would you move the E & R amendments please.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You have heard the motion. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chronister would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Chronister, please.

SENATOR CHRONISTER: Mr. President and colleagues, the amendment which I am proposing has just been handed out to you and has been printed. It addresses the concerns of the medical community in that with this amendment we will
