

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. Senator Higgins, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR HIGGINS: To ask Senator Johnson or Senator Hoagland if they would accept call in votes.

SENATOR CARSTEN: We are under call. All those senators that are out of their chairs, we would ask that you return and push in your green button. Those that can hear me, please return to the Chamber and register your presence.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Please take call in votes, please.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Call in votes will be accepted.

CLERK: Senator Landis voting yes. Senator Pappas voting yes. Senator Conway, you did vote yes, Senator.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Johnson, are you going to close on the amendment?

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Very, very quickly, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Very good. Senator Lowell Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Senator Hoagland covered the reasons for the introduction of the amendment. Senator Smith has asked some other questions which brought to light other reasons for it. I would just move for adoption.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall the amendment be adopted? I remind the body that we still are under call. I have not raised it. The question is, shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Fifteen seconds and I am going to call the vote. Record, Mr. Clerk. Senator Johnson.
