SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: With the good relationship he has, we know that won't happen. He will say, grandchild. They will say, grandad, where shall we go? And they will have a grand time of it. But despite those considerations, the Chair, I think, must be held to a consistency and a fairness. Support and visitation go together better than cold ham and potato salad, better than beer and pretzels, better than hamburger and onions, and I am disappointed that the Chair ruled as it did but we have the opportunity to correct it and I hope the Chair, in all seriousness, will be overruled.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Smith, did you want to speak about overruling the Chair?

SENATOR SMITH: I would like to call the question.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question is, shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.
