SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. May I introduce some other guests, please. Under the north balcony we have Joan Thietge of Fremont, Nebraska, guest of Senator Lowell Johnson. Would you please stand. Thank you. And Senator Cal Carsten has some guests from Plattsmouth, Nebraska representing the WSEA, Dan R. VanDyke, Ferd Goings and Vicki LaRock. Would you folks please stand. Under the south balcony. Thank you. Senator Wesely, we are back to the bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Again, I would just move advancement of the bill, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 311.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 965.

CLERK: Mr. President, 965 was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely and others. (Read title.) It was introduced on January 13 of this year. It was referred to the Government Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File, Mr. President. I do have Government, Military, and Veterans Affairs Committee amendments pending. (See reference to AM2256 on page 1474 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is anybody authorized to handle that for Senator Landis? Senator Wesely, can you handle it?

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, I don't want to intrude, but if Senator Landis isn't here, I could go ahead and try and explain these.
