The system that is being used in about 40 some other states where the Governor is accountable is the proper system, not one, such as we are venturing onto here that abandons the whole thing and turns it over to a private club. So I submit the future of economic development of this state is being decided here today on what you do on this amendment, and I am not trying to fight NACI. I am trying to say to NACI and all the others that are interested, I want economic development as much as you. I want your pressures from this political group or that political group of whatever special interest it is, but I also want the balancing factor and the balancing factor is that ultimate accountability through the political process, and now let me offer you my final proof, the absolute what I consider the final proof that proves my point. Senator Wesely said, and he is correct, he said we have got the business groups together, we got the business groups together to decide what should be done for economic development, and the first thing that that group decided was to turn it over to them and they had the power to get it done through the committee and otherwise.

SPEAKER NICHOL: One minute.

SENATOR DECAMP: I think I have a record of supporting business as much as anybody, whether it is killing Senator Hoagland's bills or doing this or that, I have got a record but that record has a line and that line is you can't destroy the political system by turning it over to "a private club of complete business enterprise." The bill can still be good and will be good if you adopt the amendment. I think you will set a bad precedent if you don't. I really do. I would urge you to adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the DeCamp amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 10 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted to the committee amendments and we are back on the committee amendments. Do you have anything further?
