

SPEAKER NICHOL: Those are not in the...?

We were reluctant to have 600 pages of copies distributed when we were concerned that the body would not be interested in having that many. Now this summary, however, Mr. Speaker, this summary that all of us have been distributed, is pretty clear. It was made out by...Senator Haberman asked who made it out, it was made out by one of the individuals who participated in the negotiations all morning.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I just thought that when we'd go to handling bills like this that members ought to have something in their hand other than what you say or some little summary thing. Maybe I'm wrong on this and I shouldn't be editorializing, but...go ahead.
