CLERK: I have nothing further on this bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is the advancement of the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? You are voting on the advancement of the A bill. If you care to vote, please do so. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced, and we will start winding things up for the afternoon. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to put in?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a confirmation report from the Public Works Committee. There will be an Executive Board meeting tomorrow at one-fifteen in Room 2102. Exec Board tomorrow, 2102 at one-fifteen. Senator DeCamp has amendments to LB 1250, Senator Warner to LB 1093, Senator Pappas to LB 965, Senator Hoagland to LB 528, and Senator Withem to LB 516. SPEAKER NICHOL: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 373.

Mr. President, Senator Pappas would like to add his name to LB 899, Senator Labeledz to LB 131.

And, Mr. President, your Committee on Appropriations, whose Chair is Senator Warner, to whom was referred LB 1082, instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be indefinitely postponed, LB 169,
