SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 901 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1525 of the Legislative Journal.) 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.
