**SPEAKER NICHOL:** All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall 795A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

**CLERK:** (Read record vote. See page 1532 of the Legislative Journal.) 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 6 present and not voting, Mr. President.

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** LB 795A passes. We have one bill left, Senator Peter Hoagland, LB 516, what is the situation on that?

**SENATOR HOAGLAND:** As I understand it, Mr. Speaker, there are four amendments that are already pending on the bill. Senator Schmit, I think, has the first amendment. I suggest we proceed with that amendment. We have just now filed the omnibus amendments that Senator Baack, Senator Barrett, and I are co-sponsoring and we are having 50 copies of those prepared.

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** Senator Schmit. Senator Schmit, just a moment, the Clerk would like to read in a few things.

**CLERK:** Excuse me, Senator. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 1027 to Select File, LB 1027A to Select File, LB 799, LB 950, LB 949, LB 1016, LB 763, and LB 765, all reported to Select File, some of which have E & R amendments, Mr. President. (See pages 1532-36 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, Senator Schmit would move to return LB 516 to Select File for a specific amendment. (Read Schmit's amendment found on page 1536 of the Legislative Journal.)

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** Senator Schmit, please.

**SENATOR SCHMIT:** Mr. President and members of the body, I had intended to apologize to the members of the Legislature for delaying this bill with my amendment. Now I understand that there is an omnibus amendment to this bill which will be forthcoming which indicates that the bill would have been addressed again anyway.
