SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lamb, please.

SENATOR LAMB: Mr. President and members, after consulting with Senator Hoagland, he informs me that my concerns have been dealt with in the amendment which was just passed. If it has not been dealt with properly, after some examination, we'll have to return the bill again. But at this point I will withdraw the amendment, hoping that those concerns have been taken care of.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. It is withdrawn. Anything else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Hoagland. Okay, it is advanced. Finally we get to special order of LB 1038 there.

CLERK: Mr. President, Select File, LB 1038. I have E & R amendments pending, Senator Hall.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move the adoption of the E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, did you wish to talk...or Lowell Johnson, did you wish to talk about this bill?

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Only that we would suggest moving it to the next position on the file.
