LB 1184, 1250, 1250A, 1258

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. The question is, shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk. We'll try the A bill since we have a minute or two.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 1250.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, 1250 is advanced. Senator Warner, do you want to try the A bill, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move 1250A, it's the funding mechanism necessary for the provisions of LB 1250.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of the A bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The A bill is advanced. Do you have anything, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a new bill. LB 1258 introduced by the Speaker for the Governor. (Read title for the first time. See page 1543 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be referred to Reference, Mr. President. Senator Haberman has amendments to LB 1184 to be printed. And your Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor bills read on Final Reading this morning, Mr. President. (See pages 1543-44 of the Journal.)
