SPEAKER NICHOL: All right. By that time you will have your copies in your bill books. Thank you. With that, we'll go on to LB 1037.

CLERK: (Read LB 1037 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1037 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1562 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1037 passes. LB 1037A.

CLERK: (Read LB 1037A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please. Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR MARSH: We'll let you finish this bill, then I will speak.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, okay. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1563 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1037A passes. Senator Marsh, please.

SENATOR MARSH: Now, thank you, Mr. Speaker. I do not have 1037A, and I also do not have 1228, and it is several rows who do not. It is not just me. I simply am the spokesperson this morning.
