

Higgins would like on her bill from several years ago. And Senator Withem and I have worked on licensure enforcement in a number of areas. The big weakness over in that department has been the legal ability to keep up with the workload, and that has been where they would like to be able to upgrade their situation by shifting some funds and have \$30,000 to do that. It does not increase their budget. It is just an adjustment in the personal service limit. There won't be additional General Fund impact. But we think it will help that department do a better job over there. I ask your support for the amendment.

SENATOR REMMERS: All right, all those in favor of the amendment vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? If you want to vote on this, let's get it done. Senator Wesely.
