

go to a cost system, then that should be 100 percent of cost. Do you understand?

SENATOR SCOFIELD: Thank you, Senator DeCamp. As you may know, my district has been the...one of the problem areas with this issue and we have paid a tremendous amount in terms of court costs and I'm very reluctant to vote on any amendment that might in some way put us deeper into court battles than we've already been. Both taxpayers in all school districts have lost a lot of money as a result of that with no perceivable benefits on either side. And I am coming, I think, to the conclusion that we need to look at the way that these things are figured so that you fairly allocate cost and I am almost to the point of saying that perhaps we need to look at that whole formula and talk about the concepts of direct and indirect cost and I think that's a major step that needs to be studied carefully before we take action. But for that reason I'm going to be very gun shy, I guess, about voting on any amendment that proposes to change those formulas until I know what I'm getting into and what kinds of impacts that might bring about on my district. Thank you, Senator DeCamp.
