

SPEAKER NICHOL: We are voting on the amendment to the committee amendment. A simple majority. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of that amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendments to the committee amendments are adopted. Now, do you have something else, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a second amendment from Senators Hoagland, Eret, and Rod Johnson to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: This is an exclusively technical amendment. It strikes three words on page 1, line 9 "or state law". It substitutes on page 2, line 7 the word "mailing" for the word "receipt", and strikes on page 5, line 1 the phrase "trustee or beneficiary of a deed of trust". These are inadvertent mistakes that were not incorporated, changes that were not incorporated when this compromise amendment was put together. I would ask the adoption of this technical amendment to the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers, please, did you wish to speak on this? The question is the adoption of the second Hoagland amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the second amendment to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The second Hoagland amendment to the committee amendments is adopted. Anything else on it, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: We are back to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Hoagland, on the committee amendments now.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Now I'd ask the adoption of the committee
