Now if you want to come up with new money on Select File, or you want to come up with new money later on to do it, fine, you'll have my vote. But at least protect those parts that we expect to have on into the future right now. I'll tell you, if we're going to have that cooperative program and if we're going to have that coordination, we've got to have the basis for it to happen. That is the intent of this amendment. I ask for its adoption. Thank you, Mr. President.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The house is under call. Will you please record your presence. Please look up to see if you light is illuminated. Those not in the Chamber, please return to the Chamber and record your presence. We're looking for Senator Rupp, Senator Morehead, Senator Hannibal, Senator Lynch, Senator DeCamp, Senator Pappas, Senator Baack, Senator Peterson, Senator Labeledz, Senator Chambers, Senator Hoagland. Senator Morehead, please. Thank you. We're voting on the adoption of the Vickers motion. And roll call vote has been asked. Please hold it down so the Clerk can hear your response. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1616 of the Legislative Journal.) 21 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion fails. Do you have anything else, Mr. Clerk?
