SENATOR VICKERS: Mr. President, just to save time, let's have a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Call of the house has been requested. All those in favor of going under call will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The house is under call. All those at your desks, please register your presence. Those that are outside of the Chamber that can hear me, please return and poke your green button, please. We are under call. Senators Hall and Hannibal. Senator Goll. There is Senator Conway. McFarland, and Senator Smith. Are all here that are not excused, Mr. Clerk? We are all present who are not excused. Senator Vickers, did you want a roll call vote? The Clerk will call the roll on the Vickers amendment.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1619 of the Legislative Journal.) 24 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The motion fails, the amendment is not adopted. Before we proceed, the Chair would like to take this opportunity to welcome to the Unicameral 27 students of Sophomore Pilgrimage of Nebraska Federation of Women's Clubs. This is statewide.
