You are not calling them criminals right now because they are not doing it on a big enough scale. You are saying they are people stressed and strapped, but when it becomes a big enough problem, you...

SENATOR CARSTEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...are going to call them criminals and you are going to send the sheriff, the local cop, and the state patrol, and we are going to see how they do against people where owning guns is a way of life, where guns are worn like we wear clothes. You all won't be out there. You will be like Reagan who says send the young boys to Nicaragua because he is so old he knows he hasn't got long, he doesn't care if nobody else has long. So I am going to watch this develop, and I am not going to be an escape valve any more. When those people come to me and say they hate Jews, I am going to say work it out with them the best you can. I hate the patrol, work it out the best you can. I am not going to tell those people refrain from anything. I am going to tell them if you believe in self-help, as you are telling me, you had better use it because they think you are just a bunch of fat mouths who will not follow up...

SENATOR CARSTEN: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...anything that you say. I am not going to advocate. I am not going to incite but I am not going to be a brake on that wheel any more. I am going to see which ones of you will take my place and do what I have been trying to do. You have got to show some concern for these people by the programs enacted. Mr. Chairman, I apologize for going over but I would have burst asunder had I not completed my thought.
