SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Morehead, please.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, members of the body, I was simply going to rise to support Senator Wesely in what he has indicated to both Senator Labedz and Senator Smith about the intention of this legislation and he has made it very clear and I think has clarified it for them. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, would you like to close on your motion? The question is the adoption of the Wesely amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion is adopted. Anything else, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wesely had a second amendment. I understand you want to withdraw that, Senator. Okay. Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Wesely, do you want to...oh, Senator Morehead.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: It is probably on the A bill, is that right? AM2664, my amendment is on the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. The A bill on it.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 286A, I do have E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, Senator Lundy.
