CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Morehead would move to amend the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Now, Senator Morehead, on the A bill.

SENATOR MOREHEAD: Mr. President, members of the body, this was an amendment brought to me by the Fiscal Office because it could not be handled as an E & R type amendment. This group of people are going to fund themselves by fees, not drawing upon the General Fund in any way, but the licensure board is going to give them their start-up costs and those costs will be returned to the licensure board from the Social Workers Fund, and they wanted to be very certain that it was returned from the Social Workers Fund and not from other funds within that agency. So this clarifies the movement of the funds so there is no question and I ask for its adoption.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the Morehead amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Morehead's amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: It is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Morehead, would you like to move the bill?

SENATOR MOREHEAD: I ask for its advancement, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. LB 355.

CLERK: 355, Mr. President, has E & R amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lundy.
