SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Goll, page 4, line 23.

SENATOR GOLL: Page what?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Page 4, line 23, it says "and surgery", that is underlined. Does that mean that there is a change in Section 33-150 of the state statutes?

SENATOR GOLL: Would you repeat the question, Senator Haberman? I see the words "and surgery" on page 4, line 23.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is it underlined?

SENATOR GOLL: Yes, it is.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Why?

SENATOR GOLL: Okay, to what we are referring is on the next page. I presume, Senator Haberman, that is a technical amendment, the correct name of the board. It does not change anything.

SENATOR HABERMAN: It doesn't have any funds from them transferred into a General Fund?

SENATOR GOLL: I can't hear you.

SENATOR HABERMAN: It doesn't change the transfer of 15 percent of all fees from this particular entity into the General Fund, is that what it means?

SENATOR GOLL: That is current language, Senator Haberman.

SENATOR HABERMAN: So it doesn't change a thing there?

SENATOR GOLL: No.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Okay. Okay, I will get off of that one and we will go a little bit further. Senator Goll, what would happen and would the Nebraska School Athletic Association have the authority to require all schools to have a licensed athletic trainer?
