SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Goll will respond.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Is infrared lights, is that the same kind of lights that is used in restaurants to keep food hot?

SENATOR GOLL: I couldn't tell you if it is used in restaurants or not, Senator Haberman.
