

as other proposed changes or increase for state employees.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Did you give me or have you mentioned the rate of increase, the amount of increase of each of them?

SENATOR WARNER: There is no increase, Senator, for any of the constitutional officers other than what is required to be paid by current law, current statute. As I indicated, the only exception would be the Tax Commissioner which does reflect the 3 percent increase from the current salary which was the Governor's salary policy and the one that the Legislature has so far.

SENATOR SCHMIT: So that would reflect a 3 percent increase?

SENATOR WARNER: Only for the Tax Commissioner.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I see. Thank you.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Warner, do you wish to close? We are now ready and will vote on the advancement of LB 840. Those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: LB 840 is advanced. We are now ready for LB 841.

CLERK: LB 841, Madam President, was introduced by the Speaker for the Governor. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR MARSH: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this again is constitutionally required, a separate salary bill for the members of the Legislature reflecting the constitutional based salary, total, 252,000. I move the bill be advanced.

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and will vote on the advancement of LB 841. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.
