

March 25, 1986 LB 853, 1001

SENATOR MARSH: We are now ready and will vote on the advancement of LB 853. Those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR MARSH: The bill is advanced. We are now ready to discuss 1001.

CLERK: Madam President, 1001 offered by Senator Peterson. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 14, referred to the Agriculture and Environment Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending, Madam President. (AM2237 found on page 1041 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR MARSH: Rod Johnson, the committee amendments for LB 1001.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Madam President, being unprepared, I will just move the committee amendments.

SENATOR MARSH: Any further discussion? Senator Peterson.

SENATOR PETERSON: The committee amendments just straighten out a couple of things and that one would be the emergency clause that we thought that should be connected with it. So I would ask you to accept the committee amendments and then I will talk about the bill.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker and members, I think Senator Peterson has done a fine job of explaining the committee amendments for me, so I would just move the committee amendments.
