DeCamp should be on his way. Senator DeCamp is on his way. Senator Haberman says we may move. The roll call vote has been requested. The motion is to indefinitely postpone 1089. We are on General File and the procedure calls for a simple majority. The Clerk will call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on pages 1665-66 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The bill is indefinitely postponed. Now do you want to go to the record, or do you want to go to the next thing, Mr. Clerk? The Clerk has matters for the record. We'll proceed then to the matter on the agenda for 11:00 a.m., appropriations override.

CLERK: Mr. President, if I might, I have amendments to LB 1139 for Senator Harris; Senator Schmit to LB 603; Senator Withem to LB 965; Senators Nichol, DeCamp, Conway and Scofield to LR 16, Mr. President, to be printed. (See pages 1666-74 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have a notice of hearing from the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee and new A bill, 851A by Senator Goodrich. (Read title as found on page 1675 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next order of business is a motion by the Appropriations Committee. Appropriations Committee would move that pursuant to Rule 6, Section 14, that the Legislature override the Governor's line item veto reductions of LE 839. Their motion is found on page 1496 of the Journal, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We now proceed with LE 839 and the motion thereto. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Is that 839 become law notwithstanding objections of the Governor, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature...
