

March 25, 1986 LB 1159, 1229

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, LB 1159 is declared passed. Next on Final Reading, LB 1229.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Beyer would move to return 1229 to Select File for a specific amendment. (Senator Beyer's amendment appears on page 1680 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: I recognize Senator Beyer.

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, on a simple bill like this I hate to do it but we have a problem and I have passed out to you or had the Pages pass out just now a letter from the Patrol stating the problem and I want to just pull it back and add the E clause so we can get it into effect because, as you can read the letter or the Attorney General's Opinion and then the county courts are starting to dismiss the cases so we are losing some money.

PRESIDENT: Anyone else to speak on the motion? The motion is to return LB 1229 to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried. We are on Select File. Do you wish to explain the amendment, Senator Beyer?

SENATOR BEYER: Mr. Speaker and colleagues, I just wish to add the E clause.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to add the emergency clause to the bill. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment proposed adding the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted and the emergency clause is added. Senator Beyer.
