

committee amendments we are now discussing? No, it isn't. Is it in the DeCamp amendment we are about to discuss? No, it isn't. In other words, of the four major recommendations of this \$50,000 study, neither the green copy, the committee amendments nor the DeCamp amendments make any attempt to meet those major recommendations. The closing statement of summary is this. Because of the complexity of the industry and the rapid level of change which is anticipated, it is important that the Legislature formulate an overall policy before dealing with specific issues. That is the single basic conclusion of \$50,000 of work we've had done in this area and that recommendation isn't followed in the green copy, in the committee amendments or in the DeCamp amendments. I, too, will vote down the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments on which Senator Schmit makes the recommendation. Senator Schmit, you may close.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Very briefly again, Mr. President, I would urge you to vote against the committee amendments and remember when you do that, Senator David Landis's admonition, the more complicated the bill, sometimes the less discussion. I well recall when we used to argue the dove bill when I first came down here. We had hours and hours and hours of discussion and some of it very emotional. We passed a dove bill and nothing ever happened, doves keep coming and going as always. If you make a mistake on this bill, it will be a very serious mistake, so I ask you to listen very carefully and to begin by voting against the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments and the Chairman of the committee recommends a no vote which will be red. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 25 nays. Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are rejected. Next on the desk, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith, you had amendments printed, Senator, on page 1582. I understand you want to
