SENATOR HABERMAN: I am going to ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Very well, Senator. A call of the house has been requested and the question is now, shall the house come under call? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The house is under call. Will members of the Legislature please record your presence light on the front board, please, see that your green light is turned on. Members outside the Chamber, please return, the house is under call. Would the members please listen to the names, we ask you to record your presence. Senator Chambers, Senator Chizek, Senator Goll, Senator Landis, Senator Hoagland, Senator Nichol, Senator Rogers, Senator Vickers. Members, please record your presence, the house is under call. The members are properly to be in your seats during the time the house is under call. Senator Chambers, Senator Chizek. Senator Chambers is here. Senator Chizek, please, the house is under call. Senator Chizek, please return to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. Please return to the Chamber. Senator Chizek is here. All of our unexcused members are present. May we have order in the Chamber, please. (Gavel.) The motion is the adoption of the Haberman amendment to 1105. A roll call vote has been requested. May we have silence when the Clerk calls the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1714 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The amendment is not adopted. The call of the house is raised. Further amendments?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Haberman has a second amendment. It is on 1222 of the Journal.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, Mr. President, members of the body, this amendment states that the training sessions shall be paid for by the state and not the counties because we mandate that they take the training sessions. Now I don't see anything wrong with having the state paying for it if we, as a Legislature and the state, says you shall do this. And that is what the
