

the interim if it does advance, to put the kill motion on Select File, even though I could get it with the majority votes but I feel this time just let the body vote against it and we will see what happens.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vard Johnson, please.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this bill probably does not deserve the kind of time that we have spent on it. This bill came out of the Revenue Committee of which Senator Sieck is a member on an eight to nothing vote. Senator Sieck was one of the eight that voted to advance the bill. We went over each of these little provisions in the bill. The committee very carefully eliminated one of the changes in the bill but accepted two of the changes in the bill including the one that Senator Sieck is now opposed to. There has been no facts, no new facts induced. There is no reason why attitudes and minds should change on this issue. It simply...it is not necessarily a question of saving the state money. It is simply a question of appropriately reflecting a balance of allocation of expenses between the county and the state for what essentially are county functions. I think 1105 as amended is a very responsible piece of legislation. It only saves the state pennies, not dollars. It is a very modest bill, but it is these kind of penny savings that if we make over the long pull will generate true savings for the state. I would support Senator Warner and his motion to advance 1105 to Select File.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, would you like to close please on the advancement of the bill? Okay, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.
