CLERK: 7 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment fails. May I introduce some guests of Senator Scofield in the north balcony, please. We have five 5th through 8th grade students from Hemingford Seventh Day Adventist Elementary School in Hemingford, Nebraska and their teacher. Would you folks please stand and be recognized. Thank you for visiting us and coming a long way to do so. Mr. Clerk, do we have anything else on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, back to the bill. Senator Landis, would you like to...?

SENATOR LANDIS: I move for the advancement of LB 931.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 931.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 870.

CLERK: 870, Mr. President, introduced by Senator Warner and other members of the Appropriations Committee. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Warner, please.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, this bill was introduced to provide a vehicle to change existing law which was enacted last session and which you will recall we transferred 8 1/2 million from the Cash Reserve Fund for the purpose of the Commonwealth issue and prior to that 5 million was transferred to the General Fund, both of which carried the provision that between July 15th and July 30th of this year the Cash Reserve Fund would be reimbursed by the amounts that had been transferred. Also, when the bill was originally enacted that established that Cash Reserve Fund, the interest that was to accrue to that fund was deposited to the General Fund. As the bill stands, as introduced, and it has an amendment which is only a technical
