CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The motion...the amendment is adopted. Now, Senator Chambers, would you like to return it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I move that it be readvanced to E & R Final.

SPEAKER NICHOL: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We can't read 804 because it has an A bill. We'll go to 907.

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 907 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1724-25 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 907 passes. We'll need to skip over 924. LB 1036.

CLERK: (Read LB 1036 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1036 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1725-26 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill passes. Let's run the A bill then you can go to lunch. LB 1036A.

CLERK: (Read LB 1036A on Final Reading.)
