All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1726 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 1036A passes. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to put in?
