

PRESIDENT: If you wish to speak on it, you may.

SENATOR HARTNETT: What I'm going to do is to add the bill, LB 1125 which is the...kind of a death benefit amendment and simply changes years. Before you had to be 55 years old for the widower or widow to collect and move it down from 30 years to 20 years, and so that is really my amendment. So I would appreciate if we could return the bill for this specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Harris.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I rise to support the motion. We need to do this in order to reinstate the issue that was involved in the issue that was taken out of LB 1129 and put into 325. So we need to go ahead and take this bill back, put the amendment into the bill and readvance it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers, do you wish to speak on this motion?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, just to make it crystal clear what we're doing, I'd like to ask Senator Hartnett a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hartnett is available.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Hartnett, in case somebody missed it, isn't this the language from 1129 that we now want to put into 325?

SENATOR HARTNETT: That's correct, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the motion to return the bill to Select File? If not, all those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on the motion to return LB 325 to Select File for a specific amendment. Please record your vote on the motion to return LB 325 to Select File for a Hartnett specific amendment. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.
