CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

PRESIDENT: The motion carried. The house is under call. Members sitting at your seats, please look up to the front board and record your green presence light. Record your presence. Members outside the Chamber, please return to the Legislative Chamber. The house is under call. Properly, all members are to be in your seats during the time the house is under call and unauthorized personnel should remove themselves from the floor of the Legislature. Senator Chambers, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Schmit, would you record your presence. Senator Scofield, record your presence. Senator Chambers, we await your return to the Legislature. The house is under call. Senator Chambers. Okay, we all here now. A roll call vote has been requested. Am I correct? May we have quiet, please, in the Chamber. (Gavel.) May we have quiet so the Clerk may hear your vote. The Clerk will call the roll. The motion is the adoption of the Schmit amendment. All those vote aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1746 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 24 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Anything else on the bill?

CLERK: I have nothing further on the DeCamp amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Nothing further on the DeCamp amendment. Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Waive closing, if this is closing.
